

IKN takes part in a new research and innovation project

The new EU Horizon 2020 project LEILAC2 (Low Emissions Intensity Lime and Cement) started on the 7th of April 2020 and IKN is part of it! The project will be focused on separating and capturing CO₂ from the cement production process. Together with other partners, such as Calix, Polimi, Lhoist and a HeidelbergCement plant in Germany, as well as many others, we will be working intensely on developing further innovative technologies to reduce CO₂ emissions.

The first Leilac installation has already been completed at a HeidelbergCement plant in Belgium. The new project including planning, construction, commissioning, and extensive test runs shall be finalized by 2025.
